The Main Street Wadsworth Farmers Market begins June 11 and runs every Saturday 9:00-Noon at 151 Main Street (CIS parking lot). July First Friday on July 1st is Wadsworth's annual Fireworks and Food Trucks event starting at 6:00 p.m. with fireworks around 10:00 p.m. Two large art murals will go up at 179 N. Lyman Street (Frontier) and 131 College Street (B.A. Schrock Financial) before the weather turns. DID YOU KNOW?...

The east side of Main Street just north of Wright Drive included the house in which Laura Spelman, wife of John D. Rockefeller, lived. As founder of the Standard Oil Company, John D. Rockefeller was reputed to be the richest man in the world at one time. The house no longer stands; it was torn down to make room for what is now the parking lot next to Wright Drive.
