Main Street Wadsworth Announces "September First Friday: Pickle Palooza" Friday, September 2, 2022 • 5:30 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.

(Wadsworth, Ohio—August 25, 2022) – Pickles are on the menu during the next Main Street Wadsworth downtown event! Pickleball, a "Find the Pickle" Scavenger Hunt, a Strolling Pickle for photo ops, and several Pickle Vendors are all part of the family-friendly fun that await visitors at September First Friday: Pickle Palooza on Friday, September 2 from 5:30-8:30 p.m.

The downtown small businesses and organizations know pickles are a big "dill" and have theme-related specials and activities for pickle fans of all ages. The Wadsworth Pickleball Club will be doing pickleball demonstrations at the library. Try pickleball at the Johnson House Museum and enjoy ice cream and root beer floats! Sample pickle sorbet and pickle gelato at Dolce at the Strand and fried pickles at The Sub Station and Blue Tip BBQ!

Begin your pickle adventure at the MSW table in front of the downtown clock to pick up a "Pickle Passport" for the scavenger hunt and a free bag of pickle chips from the Salvation Army. Other pickle fun includes: pickle painting at Brush Tips Studio and Kathryn's Craft Closet, carnival games and crafts at The Corner, pickle stories at Opal Dragonfly Boutique and more—over 20 downtown businesses and organizations will be participating.

The "Found Sounds" Steel Drum band will be performing on the steps at Grace Lutheran Church. Bring a lawn chair. Pickle fans will also have an opportunity to ride in the famous Euclid Beach Rocket Car (weather permitting). Rocket car rides are free but visitors must sign up at the event beginning at 5:30 p.m. in front of Jazzercise Wadsworth (134 College St.), first-come, first-served, ages 3 and up.
