MAIN STREET WADSWORTH BOARD & STAFF

Main Street Wadsworth is a 501(c)(3) non-profit dedicated to the revitalization of downtown Wadsworth. It is a volunteer-driven organization that uses Main Street America's Four-Point Approach™ of DESIGN, ECONOMIC VITALITY, PROMOTION, and ORGANIZATION. The result is a vibrant downtown district created through *historic preservation-based economic development*. Wadsworth became Ohio's 22nd Accredited Main Street Community in 2016.

In April, Main Street Wadsworth Executive Director, Megan Harvey celebrated her 1-year anniversary leading the organization into a new era of growth. In March, Main Street continued to expand by welcoming 2nd full-time staff member Emma Kelley to focus on marketing, communications and public relations. In 2025, Main Street Wadsworth was led by 8 dedicated community leaders on our Board of Directors, 4 committee chairs, 1 farmers market manager, and hundreds of volunteers.



Together we have proven that when a community comes together with purpose and passion, incredible things happen. These results show the economic impact Main Street Wadsworth activities contributed to the community in 2025.







Main Street Wadsworth was pleased to bring people downtown with **11 fun-filled** First Fridays! The themes in 2025 were:

MAIN STREET WADSWORTH SUMMER CONCERT SERIES

In 2025, Main Street Wadsworth began the Main Street Wadsworth Summer Concert Series as an addition to the First Friday events. The **free** concert series added **another interactive element** to our First Fridays, **put to use the brand new Downtown Pocket Park**, and **doubled the average attendance** for First Fridays each month. This past year, the series successfully kicked-off with Tricky Dick and the Cover Ups, The Ladies Night, Paradise, Bronx Country and Custard Pie. These groups ranged from top 40's covers to pop princesses of the 2,000's, from Meatloaf covers to country covers, and all things classic rock in-between, ensuring there was a genre for everyone.



COMMUNITY CELEBRATIONS



CRAFT & HERB FESTIVAL

After a **5-year hiatus**, The Main Street Wadsworth Craft & Herb Festival **returned** on **Saturday, May 10, 2025**. This event brought **7,200 individuals** downtown and featured **over 75 vendors**.



JULY 3RD FIREWORKS & FOOD TRUCKS FESTIVES

In partnership with the City of Wadsworth, Main Street Wadsworth once again hosted the community favorite, **Fireworks & Food Trucks event on July 3, 2025**. This event was record breaking with **over 16,500 individuals** downtown, **40 food trucks, 14 restaurants** and plenty of downtown shopping. Multiple downtown businesses expressed that this event always has a major impact which supports them financially throughout the year. The next day, **over 25 community volunteers** joined at Woodlawn Cemetery (the launch zone of the fireworks) to cleanup the debris from the festives.

SCARE ON THE SQUARE & WADSWORTH THRILLER

On **Saturday, October 18, 2025** Main Street Wadsworth got into the Halloween spirit with the annual **Scare on the Square & Wadsworth Thriller**. This year, the event looked a bit different, as we moved it from the traditional third Thursday, to the third Saturday. This allowed Main Street to extend the hours of the event, add more activities, and attract even more people downtown to participate, shop and dine. This event would not be possible without our amazing downtown businesses, the City of Wadsworth, Northeast Ohio Dance, and the Main Street Wadsworth Board, Committee Members & Volunteers. Most importantly, this event has grown in impact, reach, and become a true memory maker thanks to Dr. Alex & Mrs. Lori McIlvaine, the Thriller dance, and the hundreds of Zombies who have taken part over the years.



In 2025, the Wadsworth Community Television video of the event went viral with **over 1,304,221 views** and counting!



There were **over 14,800 individuals** in downtown Wadsworth on October 18.



Main Street Wadsworth was also incredibly honored to announce that this event was named the **Best Ohio Main Street Committee Event for 2025** at the Annual Heritage Ohio Awards.



Medina County Residents took part in the trick-or-treating fun, and **over 40 Different Counties and 10 Different States were represented** in event attendance!

CANDLELIGHT WALK

The Annual Candlelight Walk is one of our community's most loved traditions and it took place on **Friday, November 21, 2025**. This event is reminiscent of a Hallmark movie with the official lighting of the downtown Christmas tree, holiday decor, visits with Santa, and rides around town to the various shops and restaurants filled with seasonal songs, festive treats and more. Beyond its emotional impact, the Candlelight Walk plays a critical role in supporting our local economy. As the official kickoff to the holiday season, it draws thousands into downtown Wadsworth at the very time our businesses depend on increased foot traffic and sales. This year **5,500 individuals shared** in the magic! We could not have done this event without our sponsors: Clampco, The Medina County Convention & Visitor's Bureau, Thurber's Jewelers, The American Legion, The Wadsworth Blue Tip Festival and The Wadsworth Eagles.



These free activities evoke a sense of old fashioned holiday charm that connects generations and allow every family to participate, ensuring the joy and spirit of the season is **accessible to all**.

ECONOMIC VITALITY



DORA **(DESIGNATED OUTDOOR REFRESHMENT AREA)**

Downtown Wadsworth celebrated its first full-year with the DORA (designated outdoor refreshment area). This has made a tremendous economic impact as individuals can now purchase drinks from the restaurants and carry them throughout downtown while they shop, enjoy First Fridays, connect, and more!



EDUCATIONAL WORKSHOPS

The Main Street Wadsworth Economic Vitality Committee began hosting educational workshops in 2025. In partnership with Main Street, Kevin Denee with Eyedea Creative gave a **workshop on October 29th on the topic “Local SEO Basics: Simple Strategies to Help Your Business Get Found.”** In 2026, the Economic Vitality Committee looks to host workshops on a volunteer software, social media, and other economic tools.




DATA ANALYSIS



In 2025 the Main Street Wadsworth Economic Vitality Committee invested in Placer Ai, a tool to better identify Main Street event attendance, and provide the businesses of downtown a tool to track visitation patterns, trade areas, audience behavior and demographics - helping businesses understand not just where people go but the forces that shape every market.

Placer's technology is deployed in many mobile apps and millions of devices. Placer's technology collects data, such as geolocation data, which is scrubbed of any identifiers before being sent to Placer to protect the privacy of Consumers. Using aggregated data, Placer provides data analytics and actionable insights to Placer Customers. Main Street excited to share this tool more with the downtown businesses in 2026.

OUTDOOR GATHERING



DOWNTOWN POCKET PARK

The City of Wadsworth and Main Street Wadsworth welcomed the addition of the new **Downtown Pocket Park in May, 2025**. This resulted in a stage for performances, 2 fire pits, swings, and various areas for individuals to gather for longer amounts of time. This project has created positive visible changes, and Main Street looks forward to the Southwest Parking Lot going through a redesign in downtown and expanding upon this work in 2026.



ART MURAL PROJECT

. The Main Street Wadsworth mural program, launched in 2019 and continues to thrive. The Design Committee coordinated the commissioning of **2 new downtown murals** generously donated by a Donor Advised Fund at the Wayne County Community Foundation. These murals will be installed in 2026, bringing **the number of downtown murals to 19!**



